Section 1: Description

Description

The following information provides a functional description of the Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector, Kit as defined in Alpine Aerotech Ltd. authority dataset AAL-212-030-901.

- Due to the fact that the bell medium series of aircraft is used as often for cargo transportation as
 it is for passenger transportation, there is a potential for cargo to damage expensive composite
 panels. This occurs most frequently during loading and unloading operations, but can also occur
 during small inflight shifts of said cargo.
- The Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector, Kit is comprised of individual LHS & RHS kits. Each kit can be installed separately, or together.
- The Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector, Kit when installed adds additional protection to the panel, as it is manufactured from a material specifically designed to spread and attenuate energy.

I. Perform a Detailed Inspection on all items to ensure proper security.

II. Perform a Detailed Inspection on all fasteners/hardware to ensure proper security/torque.

III. Perform a Detailed Inspection on all items/materials to ensure proper integrity.

IV. Perform a Detailed Inspection on the Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector Assy to ensure that it is not delaminating.

V. Perform a Detailed Inspection on all surfaces in locations with anti-fretting Velcro applied to ensure no damage has occurred to the honeycomb panel.




Figure 1 LHS Shown RHS Opposite

1. Gain access to the STA 166.000 bulkhead honeycomb panel. Reference Figure 1.

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
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Installation Instructions

- 2. Remove any existing fasteners from coordinating inserts. Reference Figures 1 & 2.
- 3. Position the Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector LHS, Assy (Item 2), with respect to the coordinating inserts. Install using supplied hardware (Items 6, 7 & 8). Reference Figure 2.



- 4. Installation complete.
- 5. Perform a General Inspection of all items to ensure proper installation.
- 6. Update the aircraft logbook for the installation of the Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector, Kit.

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Removal Instructions

- 1. As there are no special considerations or additional steps to remove Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector, Kit for either inspections, or mission configuration, the removal of the Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector, Kit can be considered the opposite of installation.
- 2. Perform a General Inspection of all items to ensure proper removal.
- 3. Update the aircraft logbook for the removal of the Aft Cabin Bulkhead Protector, Kit.

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


