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INSPECTION NOTES

- 1) Perform Daily Inspections every day. Perform before flight operation.
- Perform 100 Hour/12 Month Inspections every 100 hours or every 12 months, whichever occurs first, or if damage is detected in Daily Inspection. Perform before flight operation.

SCHEDULED INSPECTIONS

- 1) Daily Inspection (General Visual Inspection)
 - A) Inspect the general condition and security of mounting of the components.
- 2) 100 Hour/12 Month Inspection (Detailed Visual Inspection)
 - A) Inspect installation of fasteners for security.
 - B) Inspect fasteners for damage or wear.
 - C) Inspect installation of Oil Cooler Support, Access Door Assemblies for security and mating to Oil Cooler Support Bulkhead.
 - D) Inspect Oil Cooler Support Access Door Assemblies for damage or wear.

Inspection Criteria:

- -Deterioration, erosion or pitting of material
- -Objectionable chafing from mating or surrounding components
- -Cracks, holes or fatigued areas in material
- -Distortion or deformity of material
